responsibility a non technological innovation process explores the realm of social responsibility in the context of innovation business practice and economic crises readers can apply related principles to their business practices and enhance their business prospects in a modern environment facing the challenges of socio economic crises this volume is intended for graduates and professionals working in government organizations and commercial enterprises to learn basic concepts about social responsibility and introduce holistic management practices in their daily and professional lives

the editors of this text contend that there is a lack of leadership in existence for deciding global and national problems colleges and universities are generally expected to produce national political scientific and corporate leaders most institutions maintain that their graduates are leaders yet few institutions explicitly address the issue of leadership and social responsibility in a systematic and comprehensive way often academic approaches consist of unfocused courses of leadership looking at leadership styles and managerial decision making within a business context basing their work on research the editors discuss what they consider to be an important programme for the development of leadership and social responsibility in schools and institutions of higher education

the primary aim of this study is to examine how parents describe the notion of social responsibility as an educational objective and to engage them in discussions of its practice in one suburban elementary school this thesis also considers parents understanding of their roles in teaching social responsibility to their children the history of the moral education is reviewed as are theoretical notions of explicit and implicit curriculum communities of practice and desired identities this study adopts a case study methodology it relies on open ended interviews with a group of parents whose children attend the school the analysis reveals that parents had different interpretations of the concept of social responsibility they believed the primary role of teaching social responsibility to children was theirs the school s role was to reinforce what is taught at home and children were passive recipients of social responsibility education
