recent research suggests that student behavior is influenced by many factors and teacher responses to disorderly conduct must be based upon a careful assessment of each student's current situation as well as of the teacher's own role in the classroom this review of the literature discusses common factors affecting student behavior underlines the need for identifying behavior problems early and communicating with students and parents and suggests 15 positive responses to behavior problems that are suitable to different circumstances five teacher behaviors that can influence student behaviors are discussed modeling good behavior designing suitable learning spaces interacting with students responding to student attempts to improve and assessing student learning for purposes of promoting development the possible impact of non classroom staff the curriculum and the community on both the development of and the solutions to behavior problems is also explored the
