esta colección contiene 17 cuentos publicados por juan rulfo a partir de 1945 cuando aparece nos han dado la tierra en las revistas américa y pan rulfo comenta los relatos que sigue escribiendo en cartas a su novia clara aparicio en 1951 se publica el séptimo en américa diles que no me maten elías canetti lo consideraba uno de los mejores de la literatura universal y gunther grass es otro admirador del mismo

gracias a la primera beca que recibe del centro mexicano de escritores puede terminar los ocho que aparecerán con los previos en 1953 en el libro titulado por otro cuento el llano en llamas dedicado a clara dos relatos más aparecidos en revistas en 1955 serán incluidos en 1970 sus cuentos fueron considerados por rulfo como su aproximación a pedro páramo en particular luvina enrique vila matas dice de éste que es el mejor relato que he leído en mi vida texto definitivo de la obra establecido por la fundación juan rulfo

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antología que recoge investigaciones ensayos testimonios y entrevistas sobre la obra literaria de juan rulfo el orden de su secuencia es cronológico porque quiere hacer ver cuál ha sido la evolución crítica a lo largo de los años desde los primeros trabajos de carlos blanco aguinaga 1955 mariana frenk 1961 hasta los de juan villoro 2000 y jorge aguilar mora 2001 las diferentes lecturas de una generación a otra asimismo los testimonios se presentan de gabriel garcía márquez 1980 y jorge luis borges 1985 a juan josé arreola 1994 y jorge volpi 2000 según se fueron dando en el tiempo a partir del momento en que aparecieron el llano en llamas en 1953 y pedro páramo la única magistral novela de rulfo

en 1953 dos años antes de *pedro páramo* salió a la luz una recopilación de cuentos con el título de *el llano en llamas* los lectores del momento como los de ahora sintieron nacer en su interior las preguntas quién es *juan rulfo* por qué escribe lo que escribe tanta desolación esa prosa tan severa y cargada de dolores soledad y violencia esta edición ofrece el texto definitivo de *el llano en llamas* corregido por la fundación *juan rulfo*

this collection of essays derives from a conference on violence culture and identity held in st andrews in june 2003 it is a contribution to the understanding of representations of violence in latin american narrative the collected essays are dedicated to the study of the problematic history of violence as a means of civilizing the region violence used by dictatorial regimes to eradicate the collective memory of their actions violence as a result of the history of marginalizing segments of the population sexual violence as an attempt at complete control of the victim the essays establish a clear link between historical political and literary constructs spanning the past five hundred years of latin american history close readings of political texts historical documents prose poetry and films employ identity theories postcolonial discourse and the principles of mimetic and sacrificial violence the volume adds to the ongoing critical investigation of the relationship between latin american history and narrative and to the key role of representations of violence within that narrative tradition

a major figure in the history of post revolutionary literature in mexico *juan rulfo* received international acclaim for his brilliant short novel *pedro páramo* 1955 and his collection of short stories *el llano en llamas* 1953 translated as a collection here in english for the first time in the transition of mexican fiction from direct statements of nationalism and social protest to a concentration on cosmopolitanism the works of *rulfo* hold a unique position these stories of a rural people caught in the play of natural forces are not simply an interior examination of the phenomena of their world they are written for the larger purpose of showing the actions of humans in broad terms of reality
