the roman legionary fortress at wroxeter viroconium cornoviorum was built on a strategic crossing point on the river severn though the site of the roman town had long been know through the presence of upstanding ruins the major excavations reported here have shown how the town plan was dominated by the underlying fortress this fortress had been established by legio xiv c ad 60 and had then been partially rebuilt c ad 66 when the legion was replaced by legio xx the fortress was downgraded in the late 70s to become a depot for stores before final abandonment c ad 90 the excavations produced extensive evidence for the laying out and construction of the legionary earth and timber defences and of an area within the fortress to the north of the via praetorian where mess halls barrack blocks and a storehouse were found as well as considerable quantities of coins metalwork pottery and glass

into the past is hugely enjoyable bbc history magazine the places that mackay visits traverses and dwells in are vividly described as a conscious attempt to revive the past there are real moments of joy and insight history today almost 2000 years ago boudica led the greatest rebellion britain has ever seen within the space of a single blood soaked year she united the tribes to deliver blow after devastating blow to the roman regime culminating in a brutal decisive battle archaeologist duncan mackay has spent a lifetime on the trail of boudica beginning near his home in norfolk in the heart of boudica s tribal territory he embarks on a journey in the footsteps of romans and britons exploring their villages towns forts and roads the passage of two millennia has buried the world that boudica knew but duncan finds that its echoes and physical traces still surround us as long as you know where to look the armies marched along the roads we still use and died in their thousands in towns cities and countryside where we still live today the site of boudica s last battle was long believed be lost to time but the threads of the story all pull towards one remarkable forgotten little corner of the english landscape from the breckland of norfolk to the back streets of colchester from the remotest corner of anglesey to the depths of the london underground duncan takes us back two thousand years to retell the story of britain s bloodiest year fusing ancient history modern excavation landscape exploration and vivid reconstruction echolands weaves the long lost tapestry of boudica s war

this diachronic study of boudica serves as a sourcebook of references to boudica in the early modern period and gives an overview of the ways in which her story was processed and exploited by the different players of the times who wanted to give credence and support to their own belief systems the author examines the different apparatus of state ideology which processed the social religious and political representations of boudica for public absorption and helped form the popular myth we have of boudica today by exploring images of the briton warrior queen across two reigns which witnessed an act of political union and a move from english female rule under elizabeth i to british scottish masculine rule under james vi i the author conducts a critical cartography of the ways in which gender colonialism and nationalism crystallised around this crucial historical figure concentrating on the original transmission and reception of the ancient texts the author analyses the historical works of hector boece raphael holinshed

and william camden as well as the canonical literary figures of edmund spenser william shakespeare and john fletcher she also looks at aspects of other primary sources not covered in previous scholarship such as humphrey llwyd s breuiary of britayne 1573 petruccio ubaldini s le vite delle donne illustri del regno d inghilterra e del regno di scotia 1588 and edmund bolton s nero caesar 1624 furthermore she incorporates archaeological research relating to boudica

though the progress of technology continually pushes life toward virtual existence the last decade has witnessed a renewed focus on materiality design mediation and the posthuman bears witness to the attention paid by literary theorists digital humanists rhetoricians philosophers and designers to the crafted environment the manner in which artifacts mediate human relations and the constitution of a world in which the boundary between humans and things has seemingly imploded the chapters reflect on questions about the extent to which we ought to view humans and nonhuman artifacts as having equal capacity for agency and life and the ways in which technological mediation challenges the central tenets of humanism and anthropocentrism contemporary theories of human object relations presage the arrival of the posthuman which is no longer a futuristic or science fictional concept but rather one descriptive of the present and indeed the past discussions of the posthuman already have a long history in fields like literary theory rhetoric and philosophy and as advances in design and technology result in increasingly engaging artifacts that mediate more and more aspects of everyday life it becomes necessary to engage in a systematic interdisciplinary critical examination of the intersection of the domains of design technological mediation and the posthuman thus this collection brings diverse disciplines together to foster a dialogue on significant technological issues pertinent to philosophy rhetoric aesthetics and science

an exploration of philosophical and religious ideas about humor in modern philosophy and their secular implications by exploring the works of both anthony ashley cooper third earl of shaftesbury and søren kierkegaard lydia b amir finds a rich tapestry of ideas about the comic the tragic humor and related concepts such as irony ridicule and wit amir focuses chiefly on these two thinkers but she also includes johann georg hamann an influence of kierkegaard s who was himself influenced by shaftesbury all three thinkers were devout christians but were

intensely critical of the organized christianity of their milieux and humor played an important role in their responses the author examines the epistemological ethical and religious roles of humor in their philosophies and proposes a secular philosophy of humor in which humor helps attain the philosophic ideals of self knowledge truth rationality virtue and wisdom as well as the more ambitious goals of liberation joy and wisdom

taking philosophy seriously initiates a meta philosophical dialogue that challenges the division between academic and practical philosophy in contradistinction to the perfectionist tradition of philosophy it offers a melioristic view of philosophy that rethinks the approach to philosophy reinvigorates its academic teaching and secures the respectability of its practitioners outside the academe it addresses the neglected topic of philosophers education through a subtle analysis of the mentor apprentice relationship and the remedies philosophers have found to its tensions it reveals the problems inherent in emulating past practical philosophies from alexandrian times the enlightenment or the 19th century and the necessity of reevaluating the tools reconsidering the means and rethinking the methods of the contemporary practice of philosophy to that purpose it problematizes the notions of dialogue self knowledge and self transformation and questions the feasibility of autonomy and self integration as well as the differentiation between philosophy and psychology it offers original solutions to the problems it highlights and points to unique benefits in the practice of philosophy that contribute to resolving the contemporary crisis of philosophy this book combines high academic standards and an accessible style and will engage academic and practical philosophers alike professionals in education and the helping professions and the general public

is shame dead with personal information made so widely available an eroding public private distinction and a therapeutic turn in public discourse many seem to think so people across the political spectrum have criticized these developments and sought to resurrect shame in order to protect privacy and invigorate democratic politics democracy and the death of shame reads the fear that shame is dead as an expression of anxiety about the social disturbance endemic to democratic politics far from an essential supplement to democracy the recurring call to bring back shame and other civilizing mores is a disciplinary reaction to the work of

democratic citizens who extend the meaning of political equality into social realms rereadings from the ancient cynics to the mid twentieth century challenge the view that shame is dead and show how shame as a politically charged idea is disavowed invoked and negotiated in moments of democratic struggle

industrial archaeology is the study of early industrial buildings and machinery particularly of the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries when this book was originally published in 1963 this was becoming a topic of lively interest and controversy among archaeologists historians architects and engineers this book discusses the aims and methods of the science giving examples of the contribution which different kinds of specialists can make this shows a fascinating slice of the history of the discipline of archaeology as well as offering insights into industrial archaeology when the term was first being used as the first text on the subject this book also lead to the start of the industrial archaeology movement in the usa

boudica or boadicea queen of the iceni led a famous revolt against roman rule in britain in ad 60 sacking london colchester and st albans and throwing the province into chaos although then defeated by the governor suetorius paulinus her rebellion sent a shock wave across the empire who was this woman who defied rome boudica iron age warrior queen is an account of what we know about the real woman from classical literature written for the consumption of readers in rome and from the archaeological evidence it also traces her extraordinary posthumous career as the earliest famous woman in british history since the renaissance she has been seen as harridan patriot freedom fighter and feminist written about in plays and novels painted and sculpted and recruited to many causes she remains a tragic yet inspirational figure of unending interest

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
