war poet most of rosenberg s work pre dates the war the son of jewish immigrants from lithuania he grew up in london s east end financially impoverished he nevertheless lived in a society that valued artistic creativity among his friends were mark gertler and david bomberg he was a painter as well as a poet and studied at the slade school of art he knew many of the leading poets of the day and his letters in particular those to edward marsh and gordon bottomley throw fascinating light on his own poetic creativitiy and the response to his work of those around him in both his letters and prose works we find an insightful commentator on both poetry and painting though never a member of any movement he was aware of the issues that preoccupied the artistic circles of his day his artistic independence gives both power and insight to his work

mathematics education majors allowing the students to learn how to write proofs of mathematical results and at the end showing them what mathematics is really all about
