if you've ever wondered about the depth of thought vs pattern playing that goes into jazz guitar improvisation you'll find the answer in this book university of north texas jazz guitar instructor and stellar musician davy mooney is as fluid in writing about the physical and cerebral processes of jazz guitar improvisation as he is in playing over tunes chord changes and modulations mooney describes the guitar fretboard as a labyrinth ruled by shapes and patterns he recounts his own journey toward fretboard fluency beginning with the caged major scale positions and connecting them with ascending arpeggio shapes the purpose of his book is to show you a way into the labyrinth how to navigate it and find your way out should you so desire five is the magic number in this book with five jazz chord progressions fretboard scale and arpeggio diagrams in five positions and transcribed eighth note improvisations mooney illustrates how five giants of jazz miles davis wayne shorter antônio carlos jobim thelonious monk and john coltrane might have approached improvisation had they been jazz guitarists written in standard notation and fretboard diagrams for the intermediate to advanced guitarist already well acquainted with jazz scale and chord theory includes access to online audio for all 60 etudes play along and improv examples

in the 21st century the guitar as both a material object and tool for artistic expression continues to be reimagined and reinvented from simple adaptations or modifications made by performers themselves to custom made instruments commissioned to fulfil specific functions to the mass production of new lines of commercially available instruments the extant and emergent forms of this much loved musical instrument vary perhaps more than ever before as guitars sporting multiple necks a greater number of strings and additional frets become increasingly common so too do those with reduced registers fewer strings and fretless fingerboards furthermore as we approach the mark of the first quarter century the role of technology in relation to the guitar's protean nature is proving key from the use of external effects units to synergies with computers and ar headsets such wide ranging evolutions and augmentations of the guitar reflect the advancing creative and expressive needs of the modern guitarist and offer myriad new affordances 21st century guitar examines the diverse physical manifestations of the guitar across the modern performative landscape through a series of essays and interviews academics performers and dual practitioners provide significant insights into the rich array of guitar based performance practices emerging and thriving in this century inviting a reassessment of the guitar's identity physicality and sound creating possibilities

this collection of studies and pieces in notation and tablature presents several major minor and pentatonic scales speed studies and etudes to build your speed and dexterity on the guitar fretboard the c a g f and d fingerings are presented as a way to cover the full range of the guitar neck in any key transition exercises help you shift from one position to another within a key and modes are presented with exercises in various positions and ideas on how to apply them diminished scales melodic minor scales and two bach inventions round out the study mastery of these exercises will lead to greater fluency throughout the entire fingerboard the available online audio demonstrates all the exercises includes access to online audio

how to master the pentatonic scale using the whole fretboard flying up and down the guitar neck is easy when you know how you just have to know how to join the dots this skill isn't exclusive to the chosen few and you don't need any special talents or be lucky enough to be born gifted there are no tricks no secrets and no gimmicks if you can play the common chords and you've already messed around with the pentatonic box 1 pattern then you've already done the hard part it's time to move on and own the minor pentatonic scale just about the most important scale to master in rock blues pop and many other genres once you crack this one important scale the rest will become even easier once you learn the basic concept of joining scales and notes all over the guitar's fretboard this book will show you how learn how to connect all the minor pentatonic positions throughout the fretboard keep your focus simple examples are all in a minor so that you can achieve results fast learn how to break the scale positions down and piece them back together to make them usable includes diagrams and easy tab exercises links to download audio examples for the exercises links to download a practice jam along track in each of the twelve keys although the contents of this book are quite straightforward it's not recommended for absolute beginners you should be able to play the common open and bar chords and preferably have at least some experience with the minor pentatonic scale to get the most out of it warning some practice will be required this book does not include magic tricks or gimmicks only things that actually work
