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literature matters because it allows for experiences important to the living out of a sophisticated and satisfying human life because other arenas of culture cannot provide them to the same degree and because a relatively small number of texts carry out these functions in so exceptional a manner that we owe it to past and future members of the species to keep such texts alive in our cultural traditions from chapter one frank b farrell defends a rich conception of the space of literature that retains its links to issues of self formation and metaphysics

and does not let that space collapse into just another reflection of social space he maintains that recent literary theory has badly misread findings in the philosophy of language and the theory of subjectivity that misreading farrell says has tended to endorse ways of understanding literature that make one question why it matters at all farrell here opposes some recent theoretical trends and through a mix of philosophical and literary studies tells us why in his view literature does truly matter among the writers farrell discusses are john ashbery samuel beckett amit chaudhuri cormac mccarthy james merrill marcel proust thomas pynchon salman rushdie w g sebal and john updike the philosophers important to his arguments include donald davidson daniel dennett and bernard williams g w f hegel martin heidegger friedrich nietzsche and ludwig wittgenstein play roles as well among the literary theorists addressed are stephen greenblatt paul de man and marjorie perloff in addition to his close readings of literary philosophical and critical texts farrell considers cultural studies and postcolonial studies more generally and speculates on the possible contributions of object relations theory in psychology to the study of literature

an awkward teen with a terrible haircut has a reversal of fortune when he finds artefacts from the future lining a seagull's nest in a godforsaken barn Presidents Eisenhower John Adams and Rutherford B. Hayes are bemused to find themselves reincarnated as horses Clyde and Magreb he a traditional capes and coffins vampire she the more progressive variety settle in an Italian lemon grove in the hope that its ripe fruit will keep their thirst for blood at bay Russell can take Antarctic tailgaters an army of seagulls or simply a window and twist a tale that explodes on the page and lingers in the mind the times

a dystopian future set underground brings to light the struggles that humanity will endure in order to survive the variety of engaging activities can be easily broken up over several weeks to coordinate with assigned reading describe in detail the city of Ember from how it looks to how it operates analyze the chapter titles and dissect what they could allude to explain what we as readers discover about Ember when Doon visits the library answer comprehension questions about events in the book surrounding Doon's investigation in the tunnels
