boundaries of sex and violence permitted in films by charming and occasionally tricking the censors and by swapping off bits of dialogue plot points and individual shots some of which had been deliberately inserted as trading chips to protect cherished scenes and images by examining hitchcock s priorities in dealing with the censors this work highlights the director s theories of suspense as well as his magician like touch when negotiating with code officials
