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seventeen year old angie who lives with her family in fond du lac wisconsin finds herself in love for the first time the summer after high school graduation

get carried away on a summer breeze with these five young adult romances set on balmy beaches evenings on the boardwalk and ice cream dates now available together in one paperback boxed set there s nothing more romantic than summer by the shore in michelle dalton s swoon worthy books young couples fall for each other in the summer only to wonder if they re destined to separate come fall in fifteenth summer a teen unexpectedly finds love during a summer vacation by a lake a townie gets involved with a tourist in a beachside island town in sixteenth summer and along the maine coastline in swept away a shy surfer gets drawn out of her sea shell by a cute beach town tourist in pulled under and two high school classmates spend a steamy summer together while the prospect of moving to separate states in the fall looms closer in maureen daly s seventeenth summer first published in the 1940s and considered to be the first young adult novel this sun soaked paperback boxed set includes fifteenth summer sixteenth summer seventeenth summer swept away pulled under

this sizzling collection of two stories of coast to coast summertime scandal and drama is sure to satisfy includes cc cape cod and partiers preferred

this rich collection of essays presents a new vision of adolescent sexuality shaped by a variety of social factors race and ethnicity gender sexual identity physical ability and cultural messages propagated in films books and within families the contributors consider the full range of cultural influences that form a teenager s sexual identity and argue that education must include more than its current overriding message of denial hinged on warnings of hiv and aids infection and teenage pregnancy examining the sexual experiences feelings and development of asians latinos african americans gay man and lesbians and disabled women this book provides a new understanding of adolescent sexuality that goes beyond the biological approach all too often simplified as surging hormones in the series health society and policy edited by sheryl ruzek and irving kenneth zola

other book on the market it synthesizes current thinking on key issues in the field and presents new research and original analyses of the history of adolescence the genealogy of ya literature key genres and modes of writing for young adults and ways to put ya in dialogue with canonical texts from the high school classroom reading young adult literature speaks to the core concerns of contemporary english studies with its attention to literary history literary form and theoretical approaches to ya ideal for education courses on young adult literature it offers prolonged attention to ya literature in the secondary classroom and cutting edge approaches to critical visual and multimodal literacy the book is also highly appealing for library science courses offering an illuminating history of ya librarianship and a practical overview of the ya field

craft is a process oriented practice that takes seriously the relationships between bodies both human and nonhuman and makes apparent how these relationships are mired in and informed by power structures making matters introduces craft agency a feminist vision of new materialist rhetorics that enables scholars to identify how power circulates and sometimes stagnates within assemblages of actors and provides tools to rectify that uneven distribution to recast new materialist rhetorics as inherently crafty leigh gruwel historicizes and locates the concept of craft both within rhetorical history as well as in the disciplinary history of writing studies her investigation centers on three specific case studies craftivism the fibercraft website ravelry and the 2017 women s march these instances all highlight how a material ecological understanding of rhetorical agency can enact political change craft agency models how we humans might work with and alongside things nonhuman sometimes digital sometimes material to create more equitable relationships making matters argues that craft is a useful starting point for addressing criticisms of new materialist rhetorics not only because doing so places rhetorical action as a product of complex relationships between a network of human and nonhuman actors but also because it does so with an explicitly activist agenda that positions the body itself as a material interface

explores various facets of creating a vibrant ya reading community such as inquiry based learning promoting and motivating reading collection management understanding multiple intelligences accepting diverse beliefs and acting as a change agent to name a few

helps ya librarians who want to freshen up their readers advisory skills teachers who use novels in the classroom and adult services librarians who increasingly find themselves addressing the queries of teen patrons
