this book explores the religious political and social fortunes of waterford s minority church of ireland community during a turbulent period in irish history in the decades under consideration an emerging and strident catholic democracy eroded the power and social position of a once powerful ruling class waterford s fearful and confused anglicans took refuge and found consolation in a community which defined itself increasingly in denominational terms this denominationalism came to be characterised by its protestant evangelicalism and loyalty to the union with britain a unique insight is given into provincial anglicanism with a detailed examination of the character of its religious life and practice there is a particular focus on one of the

most controversial figures in the nineteenth century anglican church robert daly bishop of waterford 1843 1872 described by a contemporary as a protestant pope this cleric inspired admiration and loathing as he strove to resist the advances of an increasingly confident and vibrant catholic church studies of bishops of the nineteenth century protestant church have been largely conspicuous by their absence but this book makes a valuable and original contribution to a glaring hole in this area of historiography this study of waterford s anglicans adds significantly to our understanding of the nature of irish protestantism at a time of crisis and decline

highlighting aspects of his scholarship seldom given sufficient emphasis this new volume of the collected works of northrop frye documents frye s writings on the literature of the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries apart from those on william blake which are featured in other volumes the volume includes frye s seminal 1956 essay towards defining an age of sensibility and the highly influential 1968 book a study of english romanticism with these pieces and the other published and unpublished works contained in the volume frye changed the way the transition from the major augustan figures to the romantics was viewed these works are a central part of frye s long and radical rethinking of the relation of romance and romanticism and through them he emerges as a meticulous textual critic teasing out the fine brushstroke effects in writers as varied as boswell and beddoes dickens and dickinson imre salusinszky s introduction and annotation illuminates frye s writing and guides the reader along the path of frye s five decade development of thought on romanticism this volume is an invaluable contribution to studies on frye as well as to romantic and victorian literature

defender is the first and only scholarly biography of daniel h wells one of the important yet historically neglected leaders among the nineteenth century mormons leaders like heber c kimball george q cannon and jedediah m grant an adult convert to the mormon faith during the mormons nauvoo period wells developed relationships with men at the highest levels of the church hierarchy emigrated to utah with the mormon pioneers and served in a series of influential posts in both

church and state wells was known especially as a military leader in both nauvoo and utah he led the territorial militia in four indian conflicts and a confrontation with the us army the utah war but he was also the territorial attorney general and obtained title to all the land in salt lake city from the federal government during his tenure as the mayor of salt lake city he was second counselor to brigham young in the lds church s first presidency and twice served as president of the mormon european mission among these and other accomplishments he ran businesses in lumbering coal mining manufacturing and gas production developed roads ferries railroads and public buildings and presided over a family of seven wives and thirty seven children wells witnessed and influenced a wide range of consequential events that shaped the culture politics and society of utah in the latter half of the nineteenth century using research from relevant collections sources in public records references to wells in the joseph smith papers other contemporaneous journals and letters and the writings of brigham young quentin thomas wells has created a serious and significant contribution to mormon history scholarship
