the gospel of luke was written says its author as an historical account of the ministry of jesus not only would it serve as the basis for a sound faith on the part of professing christians but it would also claim a place for christianity in history christ s ministry as luke shows is realized prophecy it is that time during which god s promise of salvation was fulfilled his teachings healing and acts of compassion are all part of the good news in luke s gospel christ s message of salvation is directed to the

weak poor and needy with an emphasis on the importance of self denial and of whole hearted discipleship thus while luke is the most conscious historian of the gospel writers his history is a vehicle of theological interpretation in which the significance of jesus is expressed in this commentary i howard marshall calls attention to the theological message of luke the evangelist his primary purpose is to exegete the text as it was written by luke so that the distinctiveness of luke s gospel may be seen basing his commentary on the third edition of the greek new testament dr marshall also refers to many variant readings which are significant in this study he provides fairly full information on the meanings of the greek words used by luke and shows which words and constructions occur frequently and are therefore characteristic of his style it is by this meticulous analysis of the greek that luke s theological intentions can be objectively determined

this radical new interpretation reveals many connections between luke and johannine traditions comparison of pericopae shared by luke and john suggests that the usual assumptions of lukan priority may be mistaken instead his may be chronologically the fourth gospel luke nevertheless treats his sources in different ways his response being both critical and creative he aims to give security to christians by including as much as possible and reconciling conflicting traditions while firmly excluding heretical misinterpretation shellard also includes a consideration of luke s use of possible sources both canonical and extra canonical and places luke acts in its literary context noting among other things the presentation of rome as a facilitator of evangelization and a promoter of co existence

for decades scholars have reached no consensus on the writing order of luke s gospel the author through a thorough study of the word order in luke 1 3 a comparison of luke s writing methodologies with those of the greco roman historians and a detailed investigation of the differences in the narrative accounts among the synoptic gospels concludes that luke writes in chronological order the author also explains how luke has employed writing methodologies commonly used by greco roman historians to write the prefaces in luke acts and divide the gospel into sections and the implications of these writing methodologies on luke s writing order he explicates the possible reasons behind the differences in the writing style between the travel section 9 52b to 19 44 and the rest of the gospel proposes the central theme of luke acts and assesses the possible implications for accepting luke s chronological writing order on biblical studies
