prestige says watson further the jurists limited themselves to particular modes of reasoning no arguments to a ruling could be based on morality justice economic welfare or what was approved elsewhere no praetor one of the elected officials who controlled the courts is famous for introducing reforms watson points out and in contrast with a nonjurist like cicero no jurist theorized about the nature of law a strong characteristic of roman law is its relative autonomy and isolation from the rest of life paradoxically this very autonomy was a key factor in the reception of roman law the assimilation of the learned roman law as taught at the universities into the law of the individual territories of western europe
