supported direct american involvement in the war as a means of stopping nazi oppression while most historians have focused on women s pacifism paton walsh connects women more directly to world events and shows how those interventionists reformulated maternalist ideas to justify and explain their beliefs our war too is a story of american women trying to reconcile the irreconcilable to preserve both their principles and their peace it expands our understanding of women as political actors and thinkers about foreign policy as it sheds new light on american public opinion over the build up to the war
