to see judith as she was envisioned by early modern french writers and their readers and to understand how the sixteenth century shaped their view of the heroine noting aspects of that story that were emphasized by sixteenth century authors as well as elements that those writers altered to suit their purposes she also examines the ways in which writers of this era made use of judith s story as a means to explore interests and concerns of early modern writers readers and spectators representing judith in early modern french literature provides a deeper understanding of early modern ideas regarding the role of women the use of exemplary stories in preaching and teaching theories of vision and the importance of community in renaissance france
