guillaume apollinaire a leading figure amongst the young writers and artists in france until his death in 1918 published alcools his first book of poems in 1913 with its wide range of verse forms and contrasting registers of style alcools had a considerable influence on surrealist poetry the poems provide a splendid example of the lyrical art in which the paradoxes of apollinaire are held in high poetic tension the editor's introduction and notes take place in the 20th century and explain allusion and difficulties in the text

a complete chapter by chapter summary of anthony doerr's book all the light we cannot see about the original book all the light we cannot see is a 2014 historical novel by anthony doerr it tells the story of a blind french girl marie laure leblanc and a german boy werner pfennig whose paths collide in occupied france as both try to survive the devastation of world war ii marie laure is the daughter of a locksmith who works at the museum of natural history in paris she goes blind at the age of six but her father helps her to adapt to her new reality by building her a scale model of their neighborhood and teaching her to read

braille when the germans invade paris marie laure and her father flee to saint malo a walled city on the coast of brittany werner is a gifted radio engineer who is conscripted into the german army he is sent to saint malo to help track down allied radio transmissions werner is initially enthusiastic about his work but he soon becomes disillusioned with the war and the nazis the two characters paths cross when werner intercepts a radio transmission from marie laure s father werner can track down marie laure and her father but he decides to help them instead of turning them in the novel ends with the liberation of saint malo by the allies marie laure and werner are both alive but they have been deeply scarred by the war all the light we cannot see is a powerful and moving story about the resilience of the human spirit in the face of adversity it is a reminder that even in the darkest of times there is always hope

in our visually oriented society music appears to stand apart from other arts yet just as a poet can write a poem whose focus is a painting so musicians have composed scores based on poems paintings and other non musical art forms in instrumental music such reinterpretations are especially intriguing as the verbal or visual stimulus does not appear in performance but is rendered in musical form in this study siglind bruhn investigates how three french composers of the twentieth century claude debussy maurice ravel and olivier messiaen express extra musical subtexts in their piano works she shows how the relation between the subtexts and the musical works can be broadly catagorized in terms of pictoriality and interiority in all cases bruhn analyzes each musical piece and each source text in its entirety and in depth drawing on her broad background in both literary and musical interpretation of the twentieth century for pianists who seek to better understand an individual work for scholars in the growing field of musical hermeneutics and for lovers of music in general this volume explores and makes explicit connections between music and other arts

the career of gabriel faur[?] as a composer of songs for voice and piano traverses six decades 1862 1921 almost the whole history of french m[?]lodie is contained within these parameters in this book the distinguished accompanist and song scholar graham johnson places the vocal music within twin contexts

faur s own life story and the parallel lives of his many poets each of faur s 109 songs receives a separate commentary additional chapters for the student singer and serious music lover discuss interpretation and performance in both aesthetical and practical terms and richard stokes provides parallel english translations of the original french texts

an analysis that accounts precisely for the nature of debussy s musical forms and how forms of different works are related geometric systems found here throw new light on debussy s intense interest in the other arts and provide links with artists he admired in other fields
