a referral for out of school suspension or push out of students you will realize that in most cases suspension can lead directly to the prison industrial complex for our young women and men stopping this from happening to your student may depend on how well you are prepared to advocate for your child we must not allow suspension to push out our children because ostensibly it may be ensuring them a life sentence of unemployment crime or even death we say it starts at home with the parents so if we can better understand our student's rights and the rights we have as parents we can better prepare ourselves to advocate for our student and to hold the school district accountable for the education of our children
