the field of disability studies significantly contributes to contemporary discussions of the marginalization of and social justice for individuals with disabilities however what of disability in the past the medieval disability sourcebook western europe explores what medieval texts have to say about disability both in their own time and for the present this interdisciplinary volume on medieval europe combines historical records medical texts and religious accounts of saints lives and miracles as well as poetry prose drama and manuscript images to demonstrate the varied and complicated attitudes medieval societies had about disability far from recording any monolithic understanding of disability in the middle

ages these contributions present a striking range of voices to from and about those with disabilities and such diversity only confirms how disability permeated and permeates every aspect of life the medieval disability sourcebook is designed for use inside the undergraduate or graduate classroom or by scholars interested in learning more about medieval europe as it intersects with the field of disability studies most texts are presented in modern english though some are preserved in middle english and many are given in side by side translations for greater study each entry is prefaced with an academic introduction to disability within the text as well as a bibliography for further study this sourcebook is the first in a proposed series focusing on disability in a wide range of premodern cultures histories and geographies

introduces postcolonial literary studies through close readings of a wide range of fiction and poetry this guide places the literary works themselves at the centre of its discussions examining how writers from africa australasia the caribbean canada ireland and south asia have engaged with the challenges that beset postcolonial societies dave gunning discusses many of the most studied works of postcolonial literature from chinua achebes things fall apart to salman rushdie the satanic verses as well as works by more recent writers like chris abani tahmima anam and shani mootoo each chapter explores a key theme through drawing together works from various times and places the book concludes with an extensive guide to further reading and tips on how to write about postcolonial literature successfully key features close analysis of texts including sam selvon's the lonely londoners j m coetzee's disgrace roddy doyle's a star called henry shani mootoo's cereus blooms at night tsitsi dangarembga's nervous conditions zadie smith's white teeth mohsin hamid's the reluctant fundamentalist tahmima anam's a golden age

michael ondaatjes anils ghost and amitav ghosh in an antique land as well as poetry by derek walcott eavan boland agha shahid ali chris abani and others discusses important new themes in postcolonial literature including global islam postcolonial sexualities and the representation of military conflict includes a chronology a guide to further reading and tips on writing about postcolonial literature

after a decade in which women writers have gradually been given more recognition in the study of irish literature this collection proposes a reappraisal of irish women's writing by inviting dialogues with new or hitherto marginalised critical frameworks as well as with foreign and transnational literary traditions several essays explore how irish women writers engaged with european themes and traditions through the genres of travel writing the historical novel the monologue and the fairy tale other contributions are concerned with the british context in which some texts were published and argue for the existence of irish inflections of phenomena such as the new woman suffragism or vegetarianism further chapters emphasise the transnational character of irish women's writing by applying continental theory and french feminist thinking to various texts in other chapters new developments in theory are applied to irish texts for the first time casting the efforts of irish women in a new light the collection also includes explorations of the work of neglected or emerging authors who have remained comparatively ignored by irish literary criticism

this book demonstrates the legacies of romanticism which animate the poetry and poetics of eavan boland gillian clarke john burnside and kathleen jamie it argues that the english romantic tradition serves as a source of inspiration and critical contention for these irish welsh and scottish poets and it relates this engagement to wider concerns with gender nation and nature which have shaped contemporary poetry in britain and ireland covering a substantial number of works from the 1980s to the 2010s the book discusses how boland and clarke as women poets from the republic of ireland and wales react to a male dominated and anglocentric lyric tradition and thus rework notions of the romantic it examines how burnside and jamie challenge adopt and revise romantic aesthetics of nature and environment the book is the first in depth study to read boland clarke burnside and jamie as post romantics by disentangling the aesthetic and critical conceptions of romanticism which inform their inheritance it develops an innovative approach to the understanding of contemporary poetry and literary influence

this sourcebook combines all the essential poems with key extracts from eavan boland's prose works including the classic object lessons from 1995

through incisive readings of ten poets from william wordsworth to alice oswald this book shows how poets have engaged with the possibilities

and pitfalls of memory linking poets uses of personal aesthetic and collective memory as well as history the book provides a new critical template for understanding how literature engages with the past

a great reference for those looking for a single source of excerpts from primary documents regarding poe s literary theory edgar allan poe 1809 1849 was an american poet writer editor and literary critic he pioneered writings on critical theory and developed an aesthetic for both poetry and the short story that remains influential however poe scattered his thoughts on writing among his almost one thousand editorials reviews critical notices essays and tales poe on prose and poetry a sourcebook of selected writings provides excerpts from selected primary source documents with each introduced summarized and carefully annotated to provide the reader with a clear understanding of poe s main theoretical statements and essential comments on writing prose and poetry also included in their entirety are the three documents considered foundational to his theories on writing letter to b 1831 the philosophy of composition 1845 and the poetic principle printed posthumously 1850 poe on prose and poetry a sourcebook of selected writings is a superbly curated single source compendium of poe s thoughts on writing

the great poems selected are arranged in five divisions according to their meters as a measure intrinsic them rather than to epochal divisions of the history of literature the paradigmatic example of this is the classical english sonnet although the sourcebook arranges five centuries of english lyric poems according to five metrical modes there is also an index of first lines by poet provided as well taken from back cover
