popular culture largely perceives the tragedy at wounded knee in 1890 as the end of native american resistance in the west and for many years historians viewed this event as the end of indian history altogether the dawes act of 1887 and the reservation system dramatically changed daily life and political dynamics particularly for the oglala lakotas as akim d reinhardt demonstrates in this volume however the twentieth century continued to be politically dynamic even today as life continues for the oglalas on the pine ridge reservation in southwestern south dakota politics remain an integral component of the lakota past and future reinhardt charts the political history of the oglala lakota people from the fifteenth century to the present with this edited collection of primary documents a historical narrative and a contemporary bibliographic essay throughout the twentieth century residents on pine ridge and other reservations confronted resisted and adapted to the continuing effects of u s colonialism during the modern reservation era reservation councils grassroots and national political movements courtroom victories and losses and cultural battles have shaped indigenous populations both a documentary reader and a lakota history welcome to the oglala nation is an indispensable volume on lakota politics

when it was first published in 1928 luther standing bear s autobiographical account of his tribe and tribesmen was hailed by van wyck brooks as one of the most engaging and veracious we have ever had it remains a landmark in indian literature among the first books about indians written from the indian point of view by an indian born in the 1860s the son of a lakota chief standing bear was in the first class at carlisle witnessed the ghost dance uprising from the pine ridge reservation toured europe with buffalo bill s wild west show and devoted his later years to the indian rights movement of the 1920s and 30s his story offers a rare inside view by an indian who successfully made the transition from traditional tribal life to the white man s world but never lost his pride in and identification with his indian heritage

a revolutionary new way to understand america s complex cultural and political landscape with proof that local communities have a major impact on the nation s behavior in the voting booth and beyond in a climate of culture wars and tremendous economic uncertainty the media have often reduced america to a simplistic schism between red states and blue states in response to that oversimplification journalist dante chinni teamed up with political geographer james gimpel to launch the patchwork nation project using on the ground reporting and statistical analysis to get past generalizations and probe american communities in depth the result is our patchwork nation a refreshing sometimes startling look at how america s diversities often defy conventional wisdom looking at the data they recognized that the country breaks into twelve distinct types of communities and old categories like soccer mom and working class don t matter as much as we think instead by examining boom towns evangelical epicenters military bastions service worker centers campus and careers immigration nation minority central tractor community mormon outposts emptying nests industrial metropolises and monied burbs the authors demonstrate the subtle distinctions in how americans vote invest shop and otherwise behave reflect what they experience on their local streets and in their daily lives our patchwork nation is a brilliant new way to debate and examine the issues that matter most to our communities and to our nation

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
