in this book teachers researchers students professionals policymakers and citizens will find meaningful reflections on the re construction of human relationships in today s society the work encourages critical thinking and dialogue about interpersonal relationships across various contexts social groups and realities each chapter offers a thoughtful analysis of current issues impacting public life and reflects the broader social and digital transitions shaping our global society the book s interdisciplinary nature rooted in the social and human sciences allows for a holistic understanding of interpersonal relationships it contributes to the development of knowledge essential for fostering inclusive and democratic communities and supports person centred approaches grounded in human rights human beings are inherently social their ability to build and maintain relationships is vital for promoting coexistence and solidarity however the nature of these relationships is evolving now deeply intertwined with digital practices that reshape how we interact communicate and connect as society transforms so must our understanding of relationships requiring ongoing analysis and reflection to ensure they align with core social values and promote well being the transition to a digital society poses opportunities and challenges for individuals and businesses as well as the fabric of human and social relationships it raises important questions about equal access human connection and preserving meaningful family and community bonds ultimately life in a 21st century democracy depends on promoting healthy lifestyles and reinforcing solidarity from a humanized perspective this includes active engagement in community life and the work of civil society organizations whose fundamental purpose is to nurture cohesive compassionate and inclusive societies

social interaction is the engine which drives an individual's psychological development and it can create changes on all levels of society social relations in human and societal development includes essays by internationally renowned academics from a range of disciplines including social psychology international relations and child development

during his lifetime henri lefebvre 1901 1991 was renowned in france as a philosopher sociologist and activist although he published more than 70 books few were available in english until the production of *space* was translated in 1991 while this work often associated with geography has influenced educational theory's spatial turn educationalists have yet to consider lefebvre's work more broadly this book engages in an educational reading of the selection of lefebvre's work that is available in english translation after introducing lefebvre's life and works the book experiments with his concepts and methods in a series of five spatial histories of educational theories in addition to the production of *space* these studies develop themes from lefebvre's other translated works *rhythmanalysis* *the explosion* the three volumes of *critique of everyday life* and a range of his writings on cities marxism technology and the bureaucratic state in the course of these inquiries lefebvre's own passionate interest in education is uncovered his critiques of bureaucratised schooling and universities the analytic concepts he devised to study educational phenomena and his educational methods throughout the book middleton demonstrates how lefebvre's conceptual and methodological tools can enhance the understanding of the spatiotemporal location of educational philosophy and theory bridging disciplinary divides it will be key reading for researchers and academics studying the philosophy sociology and history of education as well as those working in fields beyond education including geography history cultural studies and sociology

in this book militarization nationalism and globalization are scrutinized at sites of violent conflict from a range of feminist perspectives

the importance of the global rural urban matrix is often overlooked due to urban normativity but sometimes agrarian populism and a pastoral rural imaginary result in the equally fallacy of a rural normativity as in jeffersonian nostalgia for a lost way of life that never existed the nature of rurality in north america is important to study but as alessandro bonanno makes clear we cannot limit ourselves to the study of one or two nation states we must take a global perspective when it comes to the bio physical environment and the nature of the world capitalist system this collection takes such a perspective the editor frames the contributions with a meta paradigm called the new political economy perspective npep and explains the roots of that approach in classical political economy and the canadian political economy tradition of harold adams innis there are chapters by an anthropologist a geographer two generalist sociologists and a group of rural sociologists there is also a chapter on psychiatry and mental health and another chapter which discusses pedagogy the use of an inter disciplinary framework to study global issues makes this a stimulating book which provides a window on issues that are often overlooked

the book begins by developing a spatial methodology to analyse secular and post secular religious relations the spatial approach is then applied to a particular case

that of the left hand our understanding of this sinister but intimate other draws on a wide range of ideas from different religious traditions to alternative paths to salvation and self realisation

this book is an english translation of essays on marx s theory of value first published by isaak illich rubin in 1923 in the soviet union rubin s book sparked a fierce value controversy with contemporary soviet economists during the late 1920s as such the present translation is conceived as a variorum edition including for the first time in english all the essential supplementary materials related to this foundational work in marx s value theory in addition to rubin s main work this edition includes his four most important related publications as well as ten debate articles written and published by his contemporary proponents and opponents

in time capitalism and alienation a socio historical inquiry into the making of modern time jonathan martineau offers an account of the histories of social time in europe from the innovation of the clock around 1300 to the making of world standard time around the turn of the twentieth century approaching time as a social phenomenon traversed by various power and property relations this work provides a socio theoretical and historical analysis of the relationship between clock time and capitalist social relations problematizing the rise to hegemony of a clock time regime harnessing various social temporalities to the purpose of capitalist development this book sheds light on the alienating tendencies of the modern temporal regime and the relationship between time and modern economic development

three fourths of the world s poor are rural poor most of the rural poor remain dependent on land based livelihoods for their incomes and reproduction despite significant livelihood diversification in recent years land issue remains critical to any development discourse today market led agrarian reform mlar has gained prominence since the early 1990s as an alternative to state led land reforms this neoliberal policy is based on the inversion of what its proponents see as the features of earlier approaches and calls for redistribution via privatized decentralized transactions between willing sellers and willing buyers its proponents especially those associated with the world bank have claimed success where the policy has been implemented but such claims have been contested by independent scholars as well as by peasant movements who are struggling to gain access to land this book presents three thematic papers and six country studies the thematic papers address issues of formalisation of property rights gendered land rights and neoliberal enclosure these studies demonstrate the pervasive influence of neoliberal ideas on property rights and rural development debates well beyond the core question of land redistribution the country cases bring together experiences from brazil guatemala el salvador philippines south africa and egypt common findings include the success of landowners in minimising the impact of reform and a lack of post transfer support translating into marginal impact on poverty the limitations of the market led approach and the implications of the studies presented here for the future of agrarian reform are considered in the editors introduction this book was a special issue of the third world quarterly

this book broadens the scope of thinking about ethics in global social relations criticizing the leading traditions in international ethics and exploring the ways in which some strands of feminist moral philosophy may offer an alternative perspective to view ethics in international relations
