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according to outspoken presidential scholar cal mackenzie the presidential appointments process is a national disgrace it encourages bullies and emboldens demagogues silences the voices of responsibility and nourishes the lowest forms of partisan combat it uses innocent citizens as pawns in the petty games of politicians and stains the reputations of good people it routinely violates fundamental democratic principles undermines the quality and consistency of public management and breaches simple decency in short at a time when the quality of political leadership in government matters more than ever the procedures for ensuring that quality are less reliable than ever how did we get into this distressing condition what is wrong with the current appointments process and most important what can we do to fix it innocent until nominated brings together ten of the country s leading scholars of government and politics to explore recent changes in the presidential appointments process and their effects on the ability of contemporary presidents to recruit and retain talented leaders each chapter provides a special focus on a range of topics including presidential transitions the obstacle course of senate confirmation the morass of forms and questionnaires and the exasperating exhausting and humiliating experiences of recent appointees for scholars students and potential presidential recruits the book offers a candid and revealing look at the failures of the appointments process and how it has become a serious impediment to effective leadership of the executive branch contributors include sarah a binder brookings institution and george washington university e j dionne jr brookings institution and washington post george c edwards iii bush school of government and public service texas a m university stephen hess brookings institution judith m labiner brookings institution paul c light brookings institution

when george w bush and his staff finally got word he had officially won the 2000 presidential election they had only thirty seven days left to shift from campaign mode to governing fortunately for the bush team a group of presidency scholars had gathered and provided them with a wealth of substantive analysis about presidential transitions and white house operations with information covering six administrations and interviews with seventy five former senior white house officials as well as with president gerald ford the white house interview program proved an important resource for the new occupants of the west wing the white house world gathers and digests the same material that was provided to the incoming white house staff its individual chapters contain a veritable how to manual information on the dynamics of white house operations the functions of seven critical white house offices and the actual transition of president bush in a final section scholars and bush administration insiders offer brief views of george w bush s unique transition into office in addition to kumar and sullivan scholars contributing to the volume include peri e arnold maryanne borrelli john p burke george c edwards iii john fortier karen hult nancy kassop john h kessel g calvin mackenzie norman ornstein bradley h patterson jr james p pfiffner kathryn dunn tenpas charles walcott shirley anne warshaw and stephen j wayne the section on the bush transition also contains an essay by clay johnson executive director of the bush cheney transition and now director of the white house office of presidential personnel the project was sponsored by the pew charitable trusts and carried out by members of the presidency research group of the american political science association this is a must have book for all current and aspiring participants and all serious observers of the american presidency

twenty years ago austin texas was a small unassuming city whose greatest distinctions were being the state capital and the home of the university of texas today austin is touted in such places as the wall street journal and the new york times as one of the fastest growing cities in america its population shot up from 186 000 in 1960 to more than 700 000 in 1987 it is home to such notable companies as ibm motorola lockhead and tracor and in 1983 austin beat out scores of american cities to attract the glamorous high tech research consortium known as mcc

on may 3 1943 dozens of airplanes could be seen flying in and out of royal air force bovingdon airfield near london england among the aircraft seen that day was a b 24d bomber named hot stuff which carried the commanding general of us forces in europe lieutenant general frank m andrews the officer charged with formulating a plan to invade the european continent speculation was that general george c marshall had called andrews back to washington dc leading many to believe that marshall had another promotion in store for andrews tragically andrews would never arrive while attempting to land in iceland the bomber crashed into the side of a mountain with no survivors other than the tail gunner andrews s personal papers were also destroyed in marshall s great captain lieutenant general frank m andrews author kathy wilson details andrews s extraordinary life and career the first biography dedicated to the namesake of joint base andrews this book sheds a light on andrews s crucial role in orchestrating us involvement in world war ii as well as the professional relationship and rapport that andrews and marshall shared drawing on extensive research wilson raises andrews s legacy to its legitimate place within the annals of both air power and world war ii history and posits that there is a high probability that andrews rather than dwight d eisenhower was marshall s first choice for the office of supreme allied commander marshall recounted that andrews was the only one he had a chance to prepare for such a command

though just a small town sharpville has had an outsized influence on the american iron industry this book tells that story plus many more the canal that gave the town its start its railroads the personalities who lived here the churches and clubs its ethnic heritage sports heroes long gone landmarks and institutions and the traditions that make sharpville unique events whether of local note or part of national trends are here recounted more than just an account of town lore this is a thoroughly researched book that gives the reader an insight into life here in years past from a variety of perspectives anyone who lives in the shenango valley will find interest in these pages as will someone who has since moved away but whose heart still remains here the short articles contained within this book are grouped into themed chapters with many not seen before photos it makes for an enjoyable and readable account of this little burg in times past

george jellicoe son of admiral sir john jellicoe commander of the british grand fleet at jutland was never compromised by his privileged upbringing in this insightful biography his son describes a life of action drama public service and controversy george s exploits with the newly formed sas as david stirring s second in command and later commanding the sbs make for fascinating reading over four years it embraced the north african and mediterranean campaigns and culminated in the saving of a newly liberated athens from the communist guerrillas of elas the brutality of stalinist communism led him to join the post war foreign office in washington he worked with kim philby and donald macleane in the cloak and dagger world of espionage resigning in 1958 so he could marry the woman he loved he turned to politics although his ministerial career ended in 1973 after unwittingly become entangled with the lambton scandal he continued to sit in the house of lords becoming father of the house he held numerous public appointments including president of the royal geographical society chairman of the medical research council president of the sas regimental association and the uk crete veterans association thanks to the author s research and access this is more than a biography of a significant public figure it provides fascinating detail of special forces operations and the characters of the countless figures with whom he mixed

in response to the iraqi invasion of kuwait on the second of august 1990 a small group of air power advocates in the pentagon proposed a strategic air campaign operation desert storm designed to drive the iraqi army from kuwait by a sustained effort against the major sources of iraqi national power john andreas olsen provides a coherent and comprehensive examination of the origins evolution and implementation of this campaign his findings derive from official military and political documentation interviews with united states air force officers who were closely involved with the planning of the campaign and iraqis with detailed knowledge and experience of the inner workings of the iraqi regime

during the past thirty years international trade agreements have focused increasingly on areas of provincial jurisdiction in the provinces and canadian foreign trade policy kukucha argues that canadian provinces have maintained a level of autonomy in response to these developments sometimes even influencing canada s global trade relations and the evolution of international norms and standards the first comprehensive review of provincial foreign trade policy in canada the book highlights the convergence of debates related to federalism canadian foreign policy and the global political economy as they are played out in the negotiation and implementation of international trade agreements it will be of interest to students and practitioners of political science public policy and economics

in the first full biography of the former president award winning historian and biographer herbert s parmet draws from george bush s personal papers to look at the man who led america through the end of the cold war enriched by access to bush s private diaries the book provides an intimate portrait of the forty first president and corrects many long held misconceptions about him parmet shows george bush within the context of a half century of american life and politics at a time when great changes swept the nation parmet traces bush s life from his new england youth through world war ii from his leadership of the cia through his vice presidency and presidency through his loss of the 1992 presidential election to bill clinton this book will be of interest to readers of politics and political biographies herbert s parmet is distinguished professor emeritus of history at the city university of new york he is author of several books including eisenhower and the american crusades also published by transaction

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from the mind of brilliant historian robin kelley comes the first full biography of legendary jazz musician thelonious monk including full access to the family s archives dozens of interviews and an afterword for monk s 2017 centennial thelonious monk is the critically

acclaimed gripping saga of an artist's struggle to make it without compromising his musical vision it is a story that like its subject reflects the tidal ebbs and flows of american history in the twentieth century to his fans he was the ultimate hipster to his detractors he was temperamental eccentric taciturn or childlike his angular melodies and dissonant harmonies shook the jazz world to its foundations ushering in the birth of bebop and establishing monk as one of america's greatest composers elegantly written and rich with humor and pathos thelonious monk is the definitive work on modern jazz's most original composer

since its construction in the early 1960s the hydroelectric akosombo dam across the volta river has exemplified the possibilities and challenges of development in ghana drawing upon a wealth of sources a dam for africa investigates contrasting stories about how this dam has transformed a west african nation while providing a model for other african countries the massive akosombo dam is the keystone of the volta river project that includes a large manmade lake 250 miles long the valco aluminum smelter new cities and towns a deep sea harbor and an electrical grid on the local level akosombo has meant access to electricity for people in urban and industrial areas across southern ghana for others akosombo inflicted tremendous social and environmental costs the dam altered the ecology of the lower volta displaced 80 000 people in the volta basin and affected the livelihoods of hundreds of thousands of ghanaians in a dam for africa stephan miescher explores four intersecting narratives ghanaian debates and aspirations about modernization in the context of decolonization and cold war international efforts of the us aluminum industry to benefit from akosombo through cheap electricity for their valco smelter local stories of upheaval and devastation in resettlement towns and a nation wide quest toward electrification and energy justice during times of economic crises droughts and climate change

meeting at an african american college in north carolina in 1959 a group of black and white episcopalians organized the episcopal society for cultural and racial unity and pledged to oppose all distinctions based on race ethnicity and social class they adopted a motto derived from psalm 133 behold how good and joyful a thing it is for brethren to dwell together in unity though the spiritual intentions of these individuals were positive the reality of the association between blacks and whites in the church was much more complicated episcopalians and race examines the often ambivalent relationship between black communities and the predominantly white leadership of the episcopal church since the civil war paying special attention to the 1950s and 60s gardiner shattuck analyzes the impact of the civil rights movement on church life especially in southern states he discusses the church's lofty goals exemplified by the episcopal society for cultural and racial unity and ignoble practices and attitudes such as the failure to recognize the role of black clergy and laity within the denomination the efforts of mainline protestant denominations were critically important in the struggle for civil rights and episcopalians expended a great deal of time and resources in engaging in the quest for racial equality and strengthening the missionary outreach to african americans in the south shattuck offers an insider's history of episcopalians efforts both successful and unsuccessful to come to terms with race and racism since the civil war

in addition greene details ford s rise to prominence within the republican party chronicles the president s problematic relations with his staff the new democratic congress and ronald reagan sheds new light on the selection and performance of vice president nelson rockefeller offers new insights into the election of 1976 and provides the first in depth look at ford s clemency program for vietnam era draft evaders

in this national bestseller journalist sarah stankorb outlines how access to the internet its networks freedom of expression and resources for deeply researching and reporting on powerful church figures allowed women to begin dismantling the false authority of evangelical communities that had long demanded their submission a generation of american christian girls was taught submitting to men is god s will they were taught not to question the men in their families or their pastors they were told to remain sexually pure and trained to feel shame if a man was tempted some of these girls were abused and assaulted some made to shrink down so small they became a shadow of themselves to question their leaders was to question god all the while their male leaders built fiefdoms from megachurches and sprawling ministries they influenced politics and policy to protect their church s influence these men covered up and hid abuse american christian patriarchy as it rose in political power and cultural sway over the past four decades hurt many faithful believers millions of americans abandoned churches they once loved yet among those who stayed and a few who still loved the church they fled a brave group of women spoke up they built online megaphones using the democratizing power of technology to create long overdue change in disobedient women journalist sarah stankorb gives long overdue recognition for these everyday women as leaders and as voices for a different sort of faith their work has driven journalists to help bring abuse stories to national attention stankorb weaves together the efforts of these courageous voices in order to present a full layered portrait of the treatment of women and the fight for change within the modern american church disobedient women is not just a look at the women who have used the internet to bring down the religious power structures that were meant to keep them quiet but also a picture of the large scale changes that are happening within evangelical culture regarding women s roles ultimately underscoring the ways technology has created a place for women to challenge traditional institutions from within

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
