to have such an uncomplicated unaffected witness present at some of the key defining moments of the 20th century was fortunate for historians her testimony rings absolutely true when other politically motivated accounts of the last days of hitler do not andrew roberts traudl junge was 22 years old and dreamt of a career as a ballerina until the opportunity of her life beckoned and she was appointed as adolf hitler s secretary from 1942 until his death she was at his side in the bunker typing his correspondence his speeches and even his last private and political will and testament it was only after the war that the horrible reality of hitler s regime began to dawn on her and she became racked with guilt for liking the greatest criminal ever to have lived her journal written in 1947 is a startling eyewitness account of hitler s court during its final years and of the building sense of doom as the war progressed

a riveting double biography of nazi germany s most highly decorated women test pilots hitler s personal valkyries hanna reitsch and melitta von stauffenberg were talented courageous and strikingly attractive women who fought convention to make their names in the male dominated field of flight in 1930s germany with the war both became pioneering test pilots and both were awarded the iron cross for service to the third reich but they could not have been more different and neither woman had a good word to say for the other hanna was middle class vivacious and distinctly aryan while the darker more self effacing melitta came from an aristocratic prussian family both were driven by deeply held convictions about honour and patriotism but ultimately while hanna tried to save hitler s life begging him to let her fly him to safety in april 1945 melitta covertly supported the most famous attempt to assassinate the führer their interwoven lives provide a vivid insight into nazi germany and its attitudes to women class and race acclaimed biographer clare mulley gets under the skin of these two distinctive and unconventional women giving a full and as yet largely unknown account of their contrasting yet strangely parallel lives against a changing backdrop of the 1936 olympics the eastern front the berlin air club and hitler s bunker told with great narrative flair the women who flew for hitler is an extraordinary true story with all the excitement and colour of the best fiction

in 1942 germany traudl junge was a young woman with dreams of becoming a ballerina when she was offered the chance of a lifetime at the age of twenty two she became private secretary to adolf hitler and served him for two and a half years right up to the bitter end junge observed the intimate workings of hitler's administration she typed correspondence

and speeches including hitler s public and private last will and testament she ate her meals and spent evenings with him and she was close enough to hear the bomb that was intended to assassinate hitler in the wolf s lair close enough to smell the bitter almond odor of eva braun s cyanide pill in her intimate detailed memoir junge invites readers to experience day to day life with the most horrible dictator of the twentieth century

in 1940 the us army signal intelligence service broke the japanese diplomatic code in 1975 oshima hiroshi japan s ambassador to berlin during world war ii died never knowing that the hundreds of messages he transmitted to tokyo had been fully decoded by the americans and whisked off to washington providing a major source of information for the allies on nazi activities

blaine taylor has written and assembled a fascinating photographic history of adolf hitler s many headquarters both before and during world war ii taylor includes all of the private residences offices command posts and even mobile headquarters from which the nazi dictator planned his rise to power and the conquest of europe taylor recounts the background and physical description of each headquarters while also relating these locations importance to the larger story of nazi germany and world war ii restless hitler rarely worked at a desk and was almost always on the move during the war with headquarters scattered throughout germany and across the continent from the ukraine to belgium taylor describes the best known headquarters such as wolf s lair the berchtesgaden complex and the berlin bunker but he also includes many lesser known ones such as hitler s armored train amerika felsennest near the belgian border and the compound codenamed tannenberg in the black forest hitler spent a fortune on these varied sites some of which he never used ultimately and perhaps fittingly he spent his final days before committing suicide holed up in his extensive bunker deep beneath berlin

on the murderous road to racial purity hitler encountered unexpected detours largely due to his own crazed views and inconsistent policies regarding jewish identity after centuries of jewish assimilation and intermarriage in german society he discovered that eliminating jews from the rest of the population was more difficult than he d anticipated as bryan rigg shows in this provocative new study nowhere was that heinous process more fraught with contradiction and confusion than in the german military contrary to conventional views rigg reveals that a startlingly large number of german military

men were classified by the nazis as jews or partial jews mischlinge in the wake of racial laws first enacted in the mid 1930s rigg demonstrates that the actual number was much higher than previously thought perhaps as many as 150 000 men including decorated veterans and high ranking officers even generals and admirals as rigg fully documents for the first time a great many of these men did not even consider themselves jewish and had embraced the military as a way of life and as devoted patriots eager to serve a revived german nation in turn they had been embraced by the wehrmacht which prior to hitler had given little thought to the race of these men but which was now forced to look deeply into the ancestry of its soldiers the process of investigation and removal however was marred by a highly inconsistent application of nazi law numerous exemptions were made in order to allow a soldier to stay within the ranks or to spare a soldier s parent spouse or other relative from incarceration or far worse hitler s own signature can be found on many of these exemption orders but as the war dragged on nazi politics came to trump military logic even in the face of the wehrmacht s growing manpower needs closing legal loopholes and making it virtually impossible for these soldiers to escape the fate of millions of other victims of the third reich based on a deep and wide ranging research in archival and secondary sources as well as extensive interviews with more than four hundred mischlinge and their relatives rigg s study breaks truly new ground in a crowded field and shows from yet another angle the extremely flawed dishonest demeaning and tragic essence of hitler s rule
